

**Long Prairie City Special Meeting

6:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

The Long Prairie City Council met in special session at City Hall, 6:00 p.m., Wednesday March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Mayor Jodi Dixon called the meeting to order with the following present: Council members Jim Kreemer, David Wright, City Administrator Ted Gray, and Reta Dahlen. Lilah Gripne and Clint Krueger were absent.

**Council member Wright motioned Kreemer seconded to approve the agenda as presented for the Special Council Meeting. Motion Carried Unanimously.**

Reta Dahlen and Administrator Gray presented to the council a grant application for Environmental and Natural Resources Trust Fund through the LCCMR (Legislative-Citizen Commission on Minnesota Resources) for continued maintenance at Riverside Park. Reta provided a brief history of the park and the work that has been completed to date. The grant funds would be used to maintain and improve current trails and update water ways and ponds. The grant proposal amount was \$141,000. Presented is a resolution to approve the submittal of this grant.

**Mayor Dixon motioned Wright seconded to approve resolution 23-03-29-10 approving submission to request funding from the 2024 Environmental and Natural Resources Trust Fund for the Restoration of Riverside Park. Motion Carried Unanimously.**
