Direct Buy

- For large businesses \$30K or \$40K for WA small or veteranowned business
- No competitive process
- No WEBS solicitation



Agency Contracts

- Higher than direct buy amount
- Must be registered in WEBS
- Must be awarded through a competitive process



Statewide Contracts

- \$1 million/year (average)
- Multiple awards for one contract possible
- Must be awarded through a competitive process in WEBS


WA OPEN CHECKBOOK

- View agency spend on goods and services the past two years.
- Are agencies spending money on your competition?




FIND AGENCY CONTACT INFO

- WA.gov → Government agency directory.
- Look up WA state agencies to find phone numbers and emails.
- When contacting agencies, ask for their purchasing office.
- Some agency websites also have a procurement page.



REGISTER IN WEBS

- Businesses that want to sell goods or services to the state must register in Washington's Electronic Business Solution (WEBS).
- State purchasers use the WEBS database to search for vendors, even for direct buy purchases.



REGISTER IN WEBS


- WEBS is the best way to become visible to state buyers.
- WEBS is the first place the state purchasers look for vendors, even for smaller direct buy purchases.



BECOME VISIBLE TO STATE BUYERS

After registering in WEBS:

- Certify your women, minority or disadvantaged business with the <u>Office</u> of <u>Minority and Women's Business</u> <u>Enterprises (OMWBE).</u>
- Get certified for free until June 2025.



BECOME VISIBLE TO STATE BUYERS

After registering in WEBS:

 Certify your veteran-owned business certified with the <u>Washington Office of</u> <u>Veterans Affairs</u>




