

The Linked Deposit Loan Program provides affordable capital for State Certified Firms.


- Women and minority owned businesses historically denied access to capital
- Provides additional economic opportunities for Veterans and Service members
- Any business-related loan for a state certified firm made by a participating lender is eligible for enrollment and receiving an interest rate reduction of up to 2%
- \$68 Million (OMWBE) & \$1.9 Million (DVA) in funds for the program
